



PROCEDURE FOR FOOD VENDORS:

- Review the enclosed vendor checklist. **NEW:** Add the **\$40.00 refundable fee** to your vendor fee (\$565.00) to ensure the correct use of food containers. This will be refunded if you have utilized the recommended containers below. **Also, there will be a meeting prior to the festival for food vendors and a Recycling-on-the-Go representative. Look for the notice and please plan to attend!**
- If this is your first time participating in the STLAAF as a food vendor, please call the festival office **FIRST**. New food vendors must be approved by the festival staff -- (314) 325-2291.
- Upon approval by festival staff, complete and submit vendor application-agreement form by **Friday, May 5, 2017**.
- You must apply for a Temporary Food Permit, Food & Beverage Control Office, 1520 Market Street, Room 4051 – (314) 657-1539

Plans are to provide a **dedicated dumpster for the disposal of cooking oil for food vendors. Please dispose all grease/ cooking oil in this special dumpster.** Also, look for the recycling containers next to the black trash cans. There will be a sign that will tell you what to recycle. Thank you for helping us put litter in its place – out of the landfills!

PLEASE NOTE: No Styrofoam containers! Preferred food containers & cups are #1 or #2 containers and #1 PETE for cold beverages. **Avoid the following:** #3 containers, #6 plastic utensils, #6 polystyrene plastic or colored Solo cups!
